### **4. Board Trustee Representative – Mrs. Lorraine Stewart’s Report**

- Board highlights are available on Parkland School Division website.
- 1st of two meetings held on March 2 and March 11.
- IMR\_ front office renovation of PVS cost \$184,000.
- Edwin Parr Award - Awarded to a first year teacher. Two nominees.
- Beginning to discuss boundary changes. Likely won't see any changes until 2022/2023 school year.
- Transportation Fees - voted on March 11 to increase fees. Ineligible rural riders will increase from \$300 to \$450 and ineligible urban riders from \$450 to \$525.
- Approved 2021/2022 school calendar.
- Three year capital plan which includes either replacing or a modernization of Spruce Grove Composite High School, year 3 (2024/2025) possible replacement of Parkland Village School.
- Continuing to advocate for school staff to be considered front line workers and given priority for vaccines by writing a letter to the Chief Medical Officer of Health and Minister of Health.

### **5. Principal's Message – Mr. Archie Lillico’s Report**

1. Currently we have 14 ECS students registered - high number for this time of year here

2. Report cards are released on March 25th at the end of the day.
3. No school from March 26 to April 6. Have a good Spring Break and Easter. We are back to school on Wednesday the 7th of April.
4. Assurance survey will be coming out in the mail from Alberta Learning, staff and students (gr 4) will complete their surveys soon.
5. New recycle bins will be placed in 3 locations in the building for bottles, juice boxes and milk cartons starting after Spring Break.
6. We had zero responses to the ASCA survey that we sent out to the parent community.
7. Reminder we only have supervision from 7:50- 8:00 am so do not drop children off early, after school our supervision is only until 2:35. Students should go home and then come back with permission to play - unsupervised. If a parent is with their child after school they do not need to worry about going home first as the parent is the supervisor.
