- 1. Discussed the eventual replacement of Parkland Village School- is the only school on a leased site. Still a ways away. Spruce Grove Composite Highschool is priority.

5. Principal's Message – Mr. Archie Lillico's Report

- Next year's school fees at the time of this report we do not know how the year will unfold with Covid restrictions. We are projecting the following: suggested \$55 per grade for field trips, a \$12 cultural fee for bringing in an event, grade one and two \$40 for Swim at School program and \$30 for Play Parkland fee's. This can be reviewed in the fall by admin and council once we know what restrictions are or are not in place. The Swim at School and Play Parkland are tentatively booked for Spring of 2022 to reserve us the spaces.
- The announcement is out that I am retiring and I would like to formally welcome your new Principal to Parkland Village school - Mr. Todd Hennig. I know that you will all work with him and make him feel welcome as you did with me.
