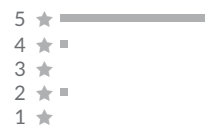
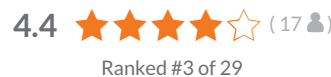
I appreciate the play parkland program this year, it's great that the kids get to try different activities.

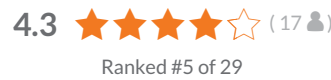
I appreciate the play parkland program. It's extra work and headache (I'm sure) but my child enjoys it so very much. Physical Activity. New environment. Fun.



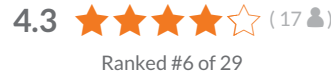

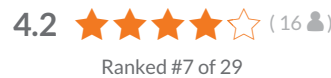
I appreciate the small classes and assistance my child receives when needed My child sometimes needs extra help with certain activities and items, and is able to receive it here



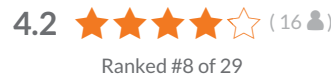

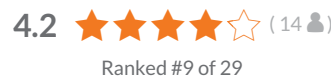
Communication with my students teacher. She is so open and quick to respond. I have confidence in her & being able to get knowledge as to what is happening.



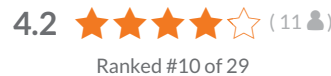

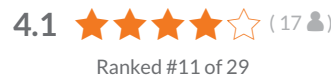

I appreciate the weekly emails! It helps me feel much more connected and up to date on what is going on.





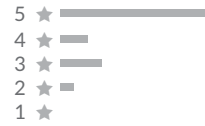
Small school with committed teachers I have a child who has special needs and the excellent staff have helped him to feel safe and confident which has helped him grow and learn

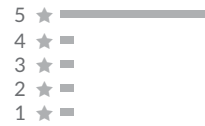
A sidewalk around PV would be nice. in winter when it is straight ice around the school, it is really hard for the kids and teachers to get to the doors.

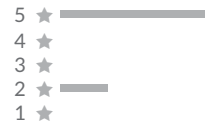
